- Timely and effective.
- Minimising non-PPE HCWs exposure to COVID suspects.
- Aligns well with surge capacity.
- Fit in seamlessly with our pre-existing system.

 - Tier 1 Pre-triage Based on patient stability
 - Tier 2 Pre-triage Segregation based on COVID symptoms.
 - Tier 3 Confirmation of Tier 1 and Tier 2 classification.

Tier 1 & Tier 2 Triage







- COVID-19 RAT was added to our system on the 15th of February 2021.
- A total of 239 tests were conducted
 - 25 were reported positive
 - 214 were reported Negative

Triage Nurse



- Adoption of infrared thermal camera.
- Maintain a spatial distance of at least 1 meter.
- PPE, Gloves, Surgical mask and Hand rub.
